- **Functional Requirements for Authority Data (FRAD)**

- RDA는 위의 개념 모델 conceptual models을 바탕으로 함.
- RDA는 위의 개념 모델에서 사용하는 용어를 사용함.
- 목록 작업이 이용자를 도울 수 있도록 하기 위함.
- 새로운 표준으로 형태, 구조, 내용을 정의
- **이용자들이 논리적이고 일관성 있게 자료를 발견할 수 있도록 함.**
 - "a set of guidelines and instructions on formulating data to support resource discovery" (0.0)
 - 이용자: 자료를 발견하는 주체
 - 이용자 과제: 자료를 발견하는 동안 이용자가 수행하고자 하는 과제

Find	to <i>find</i> entities that correspond to the user's stated search criteria (i.e., to locate either a single entity or a set of entities in a file or database as the result of a search using an attribute or relationship of the entity);
Identify	to <i>identify</i> an entity (i.e., to confirm that the entity described corresponds to the entity sought, or to distinguish between two or more entities with similar characteristics);
Select	to <i>select</i> an entity that is appropriate to the user's needs (i.e., to choose an entity that meets the user's requirements with respect to content, physical format, etc., or to reject an entity as being inappropriate to the user's needs);
Obtain	to <i>acquire</i> or <i>obtain</i> access to the entity described (i.e., to acquire an entity through purchase, loan, etc., or to access an entity electronically through an online connection to a remote computer).

Find	Find an entity or set of entities corresponding to stated criteria (i.e., to find either a single entity or a set of entities using an attribute or combination of attributes or a relationship of the entity as the search criteria); or to explore the universe of bibliographic entities using those attributes and relationships.
Identify	Identify an entity (i.e., to confirm that the entity represented corresponds to the entity sought, to distinguish between two or more entities with similar characteristics) or to validate the form of name to be used as a controlled access point.
Contextualize	Place a person, corporate body, work, etc. in context; clarify the relationship between two or more persons, corporate bodies, works, etc.; or clarify the relationship between a person, corporate body, etc. and a name by which that person, corporate body, etc. is known (e.g., name used in religion versus secular name).
Justify	Document the authority data creator's reason for choosing the name or form of name on which a controlled access point is based.

FRBR model

- Group 1 entities: products of intellectual or artistic endeavour
entities: work, expression, manifestation, item
- Group 2 entities: those responsible for the intellectual or artistic content, the physical production and dissemination, or the custodianship of the entities in the first group
entities: persons, corporate bodies
- Group 3 entities: subjects
entities: concept, object, event, place
+ all the entities in groups 1 and 2

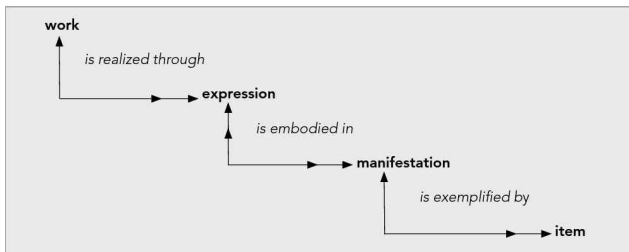

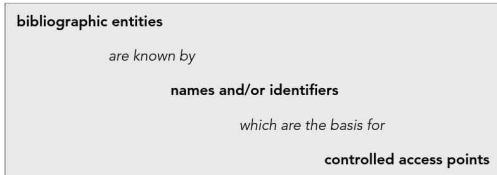

Identifying FRBR entities and relationships in a MARC record

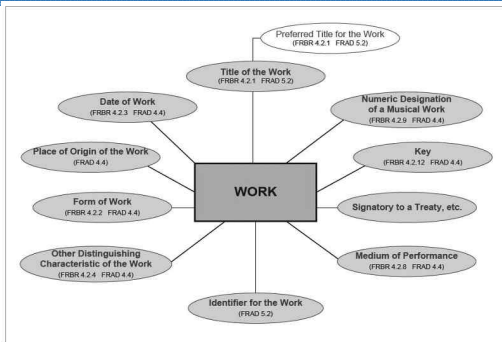

Each section of RDA begins with a general chapter that includes section-specific functional objectives and principles (RDA Toolkit, June 2010).

5.2 *Functional Objectives and Principles*

The data recorded to reflect the attributes of a work or expression should enable the user to:

- a) *find* works and expressions that correspond to the user's stated search criteria
- b) *identify* the work or expression represented by the data (i.e., confirm that the work or expression represented is the one sought, or distinguish between two or more works or expressions with the same or similar titles)
- c) *understand* the relationship between the title used to represent the work and another title by which that work is known (e.g., a different language form of the title)
- d) *understand* why a particular title has been recorded as a preferred or variant title
- e) *select* a work or expression that is appropriate to the user's requirements with respect to form, intended audience, language, etc.

Content type(marc 336)

6.9.1.1 *Scope*

Content type is a categorization reflecting the fundamental form of communication in which the content is expressed and the human sense through which it is intended to be perceived. For content expressed in the form of an image or images, content type also reflects the number of spatial dimensions in which the content is intended to be perceived and the perceived presence or absence of movement.

336 - Content Type (RDA 6.9)

The form of communication through which a work is expressed. *Examples:* performed music; text; two-dimensional moving image

337 - Media Type (RDA 3.2)

The general type of intermediation device required to view, play, run, etc., the content of a resource. *Examples:* audio; computer; microform; unmediated; video

338 - Carrier Type (RDA 3.3)

The format of the storage medium and housing of a carrier. *Examples:* audio disc; online resource; microfiche; videocassette; volume

Place of publication, publisher's name, and date of publication are core elements for published resources. Therefore, a date of publication or probable date of publication or *date of publication not identified* must always be recorded in RDA.

Copyright date is a separate element in RDA. It does not substitute for a publication date. Copyright date is a core element if neither the date of publication nor the date of distribution is identified.

If more than one place of publication or publisher's name appears on the source of information, only the first recorded is required.

Date of manufacture is a core element for a resource in a published form if neither the date of publication, the date of distribution, nor the copyright date is identified.

If more than one place of manufacture or manufacturer name appears on the source of information, only the first recorded is required.
